

Acceptance of Homeschool Credits Policy

Career Path High School

The following policy applies to all Homeschool credit transcripts

- Credit for homeschooled courses will be accepted only upon passing a Demonstrated Competency Assessment for the equivalent course through a state approved provider
- Students must first meet with the Counselor to assess homeschool course alignment with USOE credit requirements for graduation and to discuss options
- Counselor will assist student with information and planning
- Student is required to download provider assessment application, complete, and bring it to administration for the required signature
- Student is required to coordinate testing with the provider testing center
- Students choosing not to take a Demonstrated Competency Assessment for credit will be required to take all courses necessary for graduation as original credit from Career Path High

Per Utah State Board of Education Rule R277-705-3C requires school districts to provide opportunities for students to demonstrate competency by passing a State-approved Demonstrated Competency Assessment.
