Targeted Intervention Protocols

Career Path High provides a great deal of flexibility to students over time, place, path and even pacing when it comes to completing their coursework and credits. In order to maintain that privilege of flexibility students must exercise personal responsibility. There are parameters in place governing student progress in order to ensure students do not reach a level that places them at risk of failure. These parameters are addressed by our Targeted Intervention Protocols. Targeted Intervention removes some of the flexibility and creates a more structured environment. All students and their parents were informed about our school policies as they relate to mandatory attendance requirements under our Targeted Intervention Protocols during orientation and course registration.

Targeted Intervention is put in place to ensure students receive the necessary help in a structured environment to get on pace and complete the required requisites for a timely graduation. As a result of Targeted Intervention the following will occur:

- 1. Notification by your Success Coach.
- 2. Requirement to attend Learning Center during set hours until administration removes student from Targeted Intervention.
- 3. <u>Assigned attendance times related to Targeted Intervention will be</u>

 <u>mandatory. Failure to attend on the designated days and times will result in truancy and an unexcused absence.</u>

Here are the parameters that will determine the Targeted Intervention Level students will be placed on along with the coordinating weekly mandatory attendance hours. Students will be placed on a TI Level that is determined by the total number of weeks they are off pace in one or more courses:

Level 1: 2 to 4 weeks Off Pace

• Mandatory Attendance Requirement = 6 hrs. Weekly/2 days

Level 2: 4 to 5 weeks Off Pace

• Mandatory Attendance Requirement = 12 hrs. Weekly/3 to 4 days

Level 3: 5 or more weeks Off Pace

- Mandatory Attendance Requirement = 12 hrs. Weekly/3 to 4 days
- Loss of full-time use of school-issued laptop
 - Available on daily check-out/check-in basis only
- Bumped from DATC Program until back on pace

When a student is off pace by two or more weeks in any course, they will be assigned Targeted Intervention

- ❖ Targeted Intervention is a school protocol designed to assist students with getting back on pace through personalized instruction time assigned in the Learning Center
 - Like all assigned attendance times at Career Path High, attendance is mandatory and falls under the requirements of our attendance policies. Students who do not attend will receive an unexcused absence. For information about our attendance policies, including our Red Alert truancy policy visit our website at www.careerpathhigh.org
 - Students assigned to Targeted Intervention are assigned regular mandatory attendance times in the Learning Center
 - ➤ The number of assigned hours are determined by the level of Targeted Intervention the student qualifies for
 - ➤ The level is determined by the number of weeks the student is off pace in their coursework.
 - ➤ During Targeted Intervention students are assigned to work directly with the instructor at their station. Their assigned time will be divided across the courses associated with their Targeted Intervention. Instruction time may include assigned math tutoring
 - ➤ While student requests are taken into consideration, assigned attendance times are ultimately determined by the Success Coach and designed to provide the student with the best learning plan
